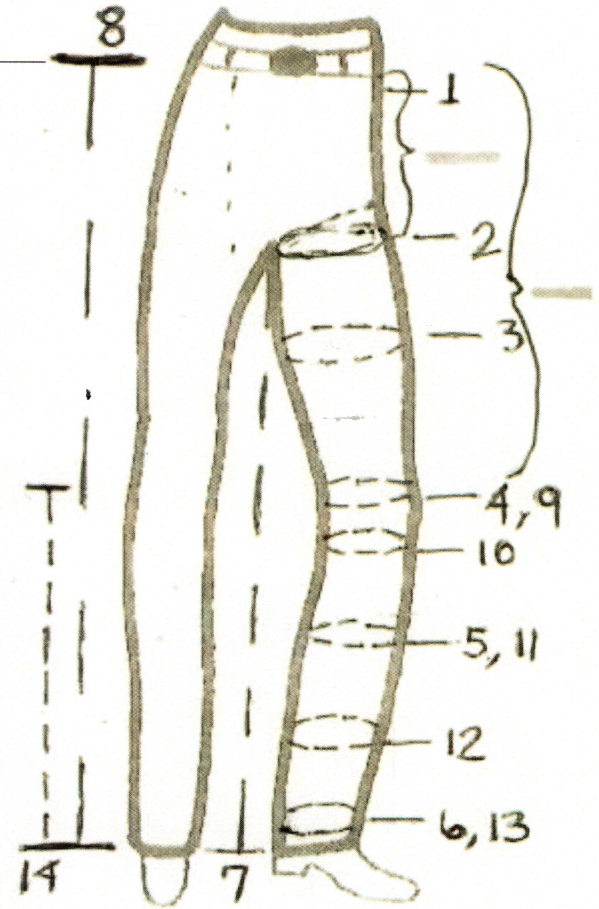

Full Chaps	Left	Right
1. Waist - 14" - 1/2" below belt		
2. Upper thigh - measure under cheek		
3. Mid - thigh - 4" down from upper thigh		
4. Knee - measure straight across the kneecap		
5. Calf - measure the widest part		
6. Ankle - (for English Chaps) measure just above bone		
7. Inseam - measure down to top of boot heel		
8. Out seam - measure down to top of boot heel		

Half Chaps	Left	Right
9. Knee - measure straight across the kneecap		
10. Below Knee - measure just below kneecap		
11. Upper Calf - measure the widest part		
12. Lower Calf - measure halfway between upper calf and ankle bone		
13. Ankle - (for English Chaps) measure just above bone		
14. Out seam - measure mid - knee down to top of boot heel		



Please also measure the distance from #1 to #2 and #1 to #4 and insert above (see arrows).

All measurements need to be precise to ensure proper fitting.
